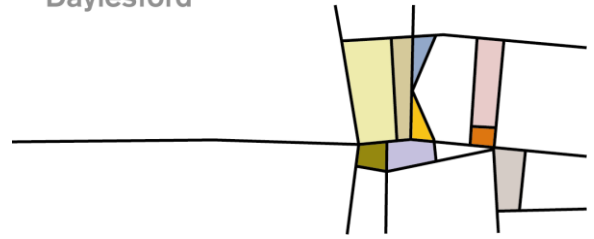

Ross thrives as an active member of the Watercolour Society of Victoria and as always remains a passionate believer of the fundamental expression of art through painting.

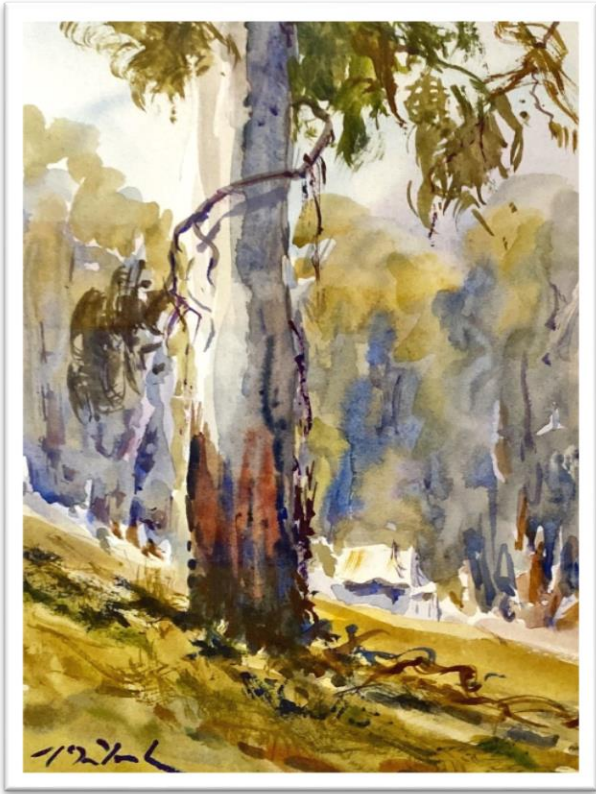

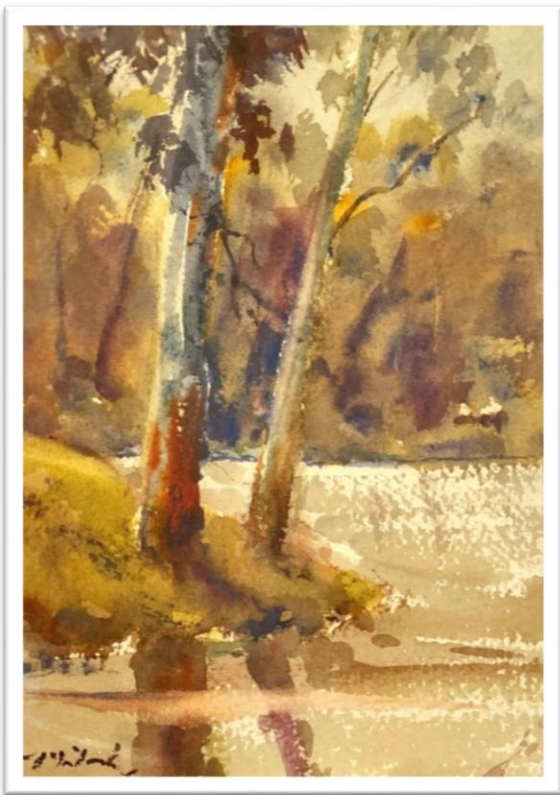
