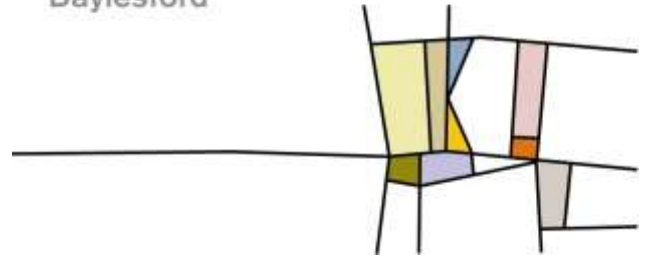

Apart from employment stints back at Myer Ad Dept. and subsequently as Creative Director of Buckley & Nunn's Advertising Department, Sandy has done work for many clients including Portmans Stores, St Kilda Football Club's Marketing Department, Your Sport Magazine (Creative Director), Enni Fashion Shops, McMahon's Farm Knitting Books, Matchbox Stores, Gabriel Gate's Cookery Shop, Interact Technologies and Brandon Park Shopping Centre to name a few.

1997 to 2000 – Sandy joined a watercolour painting course in Ashburton run by renowned watercolourist Allan Rawardy.

2003 - First solo exhibition of watercolours and photography at Gardiner Contemporary Gallery in Hawthorn.

2004 - Second solo exhibition of watercolours & photography and a three-month residency at The Sofitel Hotel in Melbourne's CBD.

2009 – Sandy moved to Daylesford to live (and retire from my working life). Sandy converted from watercolours to acrylics, regularly entering the Daylesford Art Show. Sandy has also produced a range of cards for the tourist trade using her photos of Daylesford.

2024 - Solo exhibition of my botanical art at The Convent Gallery in Daylesford also incorporating a retrospective of my career in art and design.
